

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_STDERR – redirect stderr to another stream

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_STDERR, FILE *stream);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a FILE \* as parameter. Tell libcurl to use this *stream* instead of stderr when showing the progress meter and displaying *CURLOPT\_VERBOSE(3)* data.

**DEFAULT**

stderr

**PROTOCOLS**

All

**EXAMPLE**

```
CURL *curl = curl_easy_init();
FILE *filep = fopen("dump", "wb");
if(curl) {
    curl_easy_setopt(curl, CURLOPT_URL, "http://example.com");
    curl_easy_setopt(curl, CURLOPT_STDERR, filep);

    curl_easy_perform(curl);
}
```
